

Notice: Request for Proposals

Development of an e-Centralized Public Procurement information system and upgrade of the e-Procurement Portal.

Millennium Partners is implementing the US Agency for International Development (USAID) funded E-Governance Activity in Bosnia and Herzegovina (BiH) to improve transparency, efficiency, and accountability of government-led processes. Millennium Partners is issuing a notice request for proposals (RFP) from organizations to provide services to develop an e-Centralized Public Procurement (e-CPP) information system and upgrade of the e-Procurement Portal. A Firm Fixed Price contract will be issued to the selected organization.

Interested applications must meet the RFP's minimum eligibility criteria as described below:

- 1. Proof of at least one successful Implementation, Upgrade or Maintenance of a public procurement information system by the institution that has been in production or supporting for at least two years.
- 2. A written letter of recommendation on the Institution Letterhead by the institution where the public procurement information system was successfully implemented and/or maintained.
- 3. At least an average of 500 000 USD in annual revenue in years (2020, 2019, 2018)- please submit signed copy of the annual business income statement. The dollar exchange rate on the last day of the year will be used (December 31).
- 4. The Bidder needs to provide a list and copies of Microsoft developer certifications owned by their team

Millennium Partners reserves the right to verify submitted information. All documents should be signed, sealed, scanned, and delivered by e-mail.

The detailed RFP will be issued to the qualified bidders on February 4, 2022.
