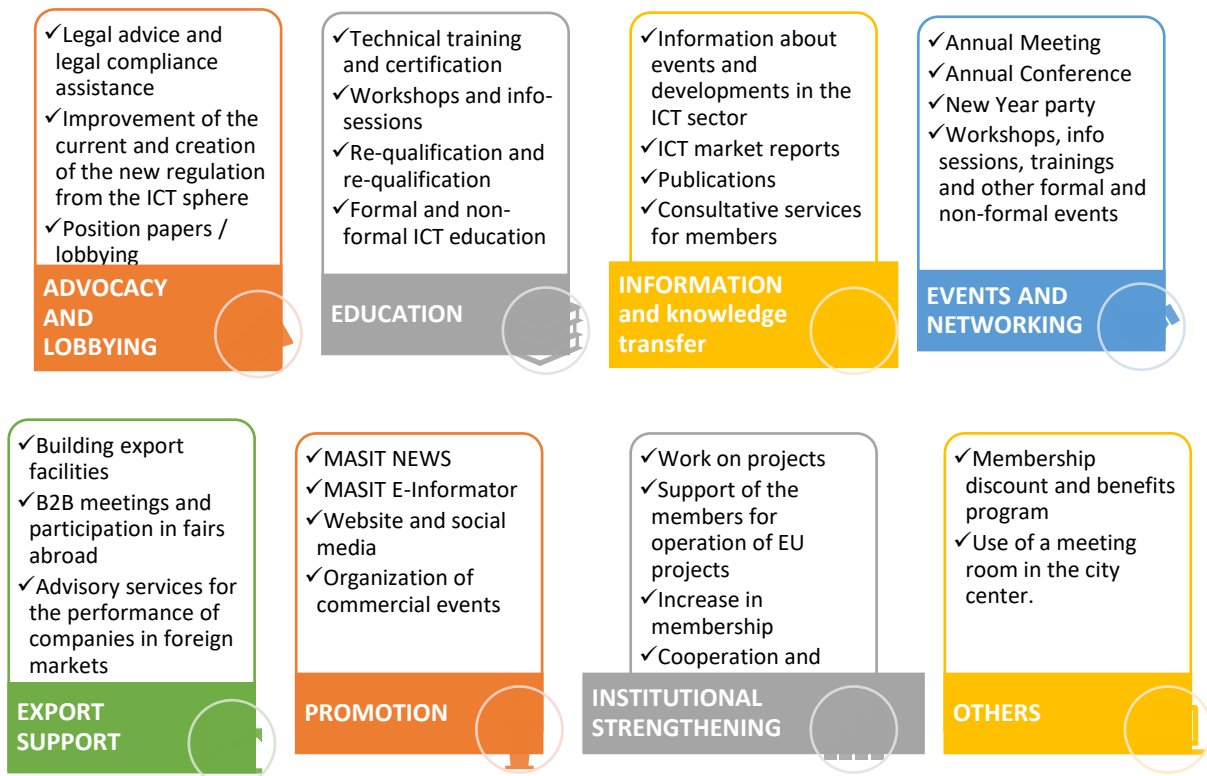

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP

Regular membership



- ✓ A legal entity that has registered a predominant activity in the wider field of ICT
- ✓ has its headquarters in the Republic of Macedonia
- ✓ has registered activity for over a year
- ✓ is active in the legal market
- ✓ is not in bankruptcy, liquidation or compulsory settlement proceedings leading to bankruptcy or liquidation
- ✓ he has not been imposed a measure prohibiting him from performing an activity
- ✓ in the market of goods and services works in accordance with the standards of the Code of Honor of MASIT

Associate membership

Associate membership means membership which, in terms of rights and obligations, is equal to regular membership with the exception of the right to membership in the bodies of MASIT. However, the associate member has the right to attend and discuss and make proposals at the meetings of the Management Board and the Supervisory Board, which right is not limited, but without the right to vote.

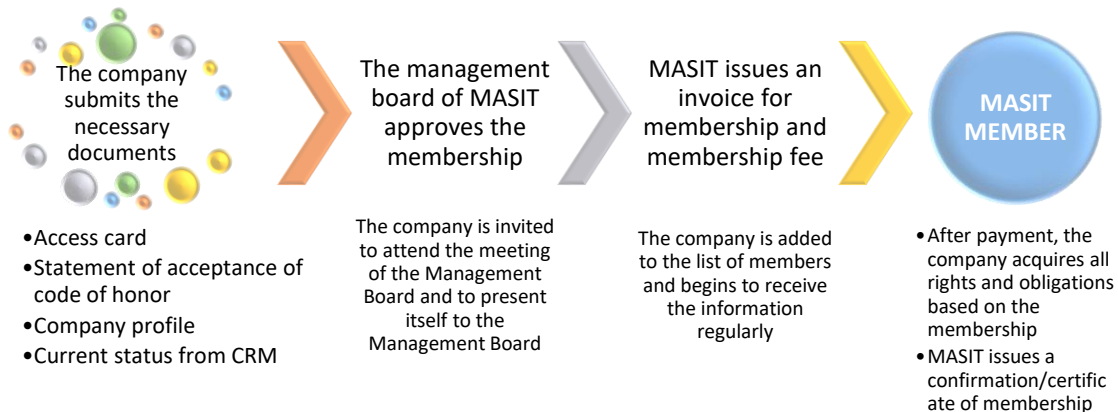
- ✓ International companies and generally recognized brands in the field of information and communication technologies can join as associate members in MASIT if they do not have a registered entity with the status of a legal entity based in the Republic of Macedonia, but have a local representative or contact person.
- ✓ Educational institutions from the Republic of Macedonia (universities, faculties, high schools) can join as associate members in MASIT.
- ✓ Legal entities from the Republic of Macedonia with registered status in the Register of other legal entities at the Central Registry of Macedonia, as well as companies whose main activity is not in the field of ICT, can become associate members of the Chamber of Commerce for Information and Communication Technologies - MASIT Skopje, if they have activities in their operations that have a touch and benefit the ICT industry.

- Amounts are invoiced in Denar equivalents and + 18% VAT is calculated on them
- The annual membership fee is defined depending on the size of the member companies in relation to their annual income in the last fiscal year, based on the data submitted to the Central Registry of the Republic of Macedonia.
- For companies that will become members of MASIT during the year, the membership fee is calculated accordingly according to the number of remaining months in the current year, counted from the beginning of the next month from the day of membership.

REGULATION RELATING TO MEMBERSHIP

STATUTE of the Chamber of Commerce for Information and Communication Technologies - MASIT Skopje

The Chamber of Commerce for Information and Communication Technologies MASIT Skopje is the basis for the advancement of the legal-economic and business environment in the Republic of Macedonia, the advancement of professional and business customs and norms, the establishment of cooperation with relevant domestic and foreign institutions, representation and protection of the interests of the economic entities on the territory of the Republic of Macedonia, which work in the field of information and communication technology (hereinafter: ICT).

The Chamber is made up of legal and natural persons performing activities with headquarters or residence in the Republic of Macedonia, who perform activities in the field of information technology and communications, and who confirm their status by entry in an appropriate register or in another way by which they are identified. status.

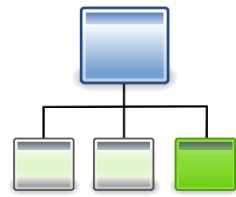
